



## Preparation of case studies and guidance on Island Ecosystem Management in the Pacific

Ecosystem management aims to conserve major ecological services and restore natural resources while meeting the socioeconomic, political and cultural and needs of current and future generations.

In partnership with the Wildlife Conservation Society, Alluvium developed a series of case studies and guidelines for best practice Island Ecosystem Management for the Secretariat of the Pacific Regional Environment Programme.

The guidance on best practice ecosystem management is based on marine and terrestrial case studies of Ecosystem Based Adaptation and Ecosystem Based Management within Pacific islands, with additional reference to work in small island developing states elsewhere across the world. The main case studies and guidance document is supported by a synthesis document and electronic materials for use in communicating, promoting and implementing the guidelines.
